GENERAL CERTIFICATE in BEEKEEPING HUSBANDRY	£80	28 th February	Must hold Basic Certificate. Held at apiary of Candidate.
ADVANCED CERTIFICATE in BEEKEEPING HUSBANDRY	£120	28 th February	Must hold General Certificate in Beekeeping Husbandry To be held at Stoneleigh on 17/18/19 May 2024 and 12/13/14 July 2024 depending on numbers
SHOW JUDGE	£40	N/A	Must hold Basic Certificate. See entry requirements in Prospectus
MICROSCOPY	£80	31 st August	Must hold Basic Certificate. To be held at The National Beekeeping Centre at Stoneleigh Park. 23/24 November 2024 plus other dates as required

Cancellations

Deferrals are not available. Refunds will only be considered in the event of illness, injury of the candidate, death of an immediate family member or other exceptional event beyond the candidate's control occurring within two (2) weeks prior to the Examination or Assessment. The Examination Board Secretary must be informed before the commencement of the examination or assessment and full details will be submitted to the Board Secretary within two weeks of being requested. The Board will then decide whether the Examination or Assessment fee is forfeit. This paragraph will be applied sympathetically. Candidates have the right to cancel within 14 days of acceptance of the Terms & Conditions. However, the candidate waives their right to cancel if they take the exam or assessment within the 14 day period.
